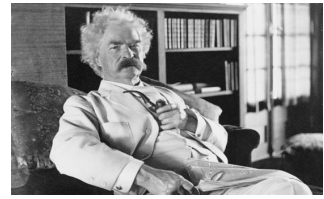




MARK TWAIN FEST
TO ALL 4TH AND 5TH GRADERS



To attend the March Mark Twain FEST (lunch, read poster and other activities)

YOU MUST READ 6 MARK TWAIN, CALDECOTT OR NEWBERRY BOOKS. 3 OF THE 6 MUST BE FROM THE 2009-2010 MARK TWAIN NOMINEE BOOKS.

You will make a book report or activity or project for each book you read. Below is a list of the different types of book reports, activities and projects you can make. All books read should have different book reports, activity or projects.

This must be finished by March 1, 2010 to attend the Mark Twain Fest.

1. You may draw a comic strip of your favorite scene or of the main idea of the story.
2. Use a shoebox or similar item to make a model of a scene or the main idea of the story.
3. You may use magazine and/or newspaper picture to create a collage about the story.
4. Create a postcard to send to one of the characters from the story. In it, recall the story events he or she was involved in and why you would like to meet the character in real life.
5. Make a poster about your book as if you were introducing to the world like a movie.
6. Make a bookmark addressing key elements of a book report such as plot summary, setting conflict, and resolution on one side. Illustrate a scene from the book on the other.
7. Create a mini-book about the story either by sequencing the plot line or describing each of the characters.
8. Create a time line sequencing the events in the story. About each entry on the time line illustrate the event.
9. Write a poem or rap song about the story, make sure to include various scenes or events from the plot line.
10. You may get a book report form from the library.
